1 Gloucester National Park - Gloucester and Bicentennial Trees

For the adventurous there is the Gloucester Tree and the Bicentennial Tree. These are the trees which were used as forest fire lookouts during summer months and can now be climbed by visitors. Make sure you have good sturdy climbing shoes and a head for heights! As these are in the national park there is a small entrance fee.

2 Big Brook Dam

Perfect for the keen fisherman and for the family. With a unique fresh water swimming beach and lots of picnic facilities it's just right for a barbeque or picnic.

3 Trout Hatchery

The trout hatchery was established in 1935 to grow brown and rainbow trout to be released into the local rivers. It is operated by the Department of Fisheries.

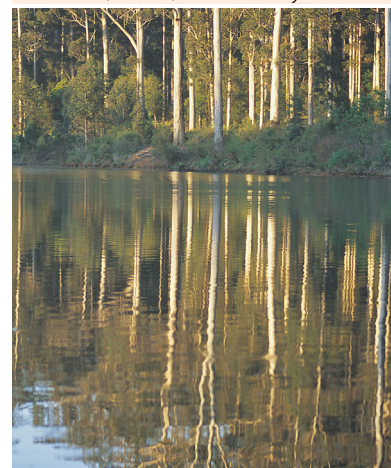

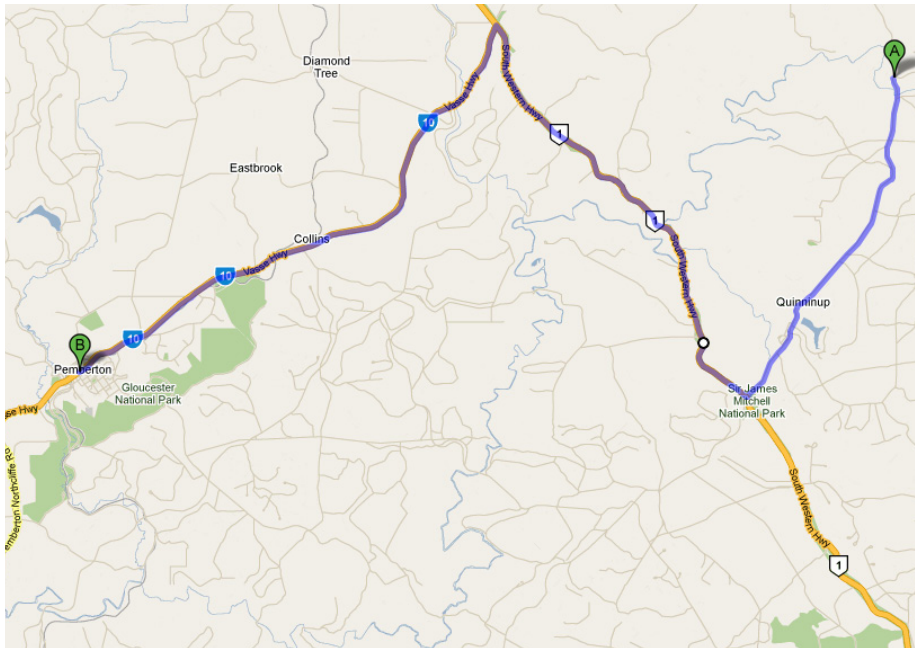

To get to Pemberton from Clover Cottage

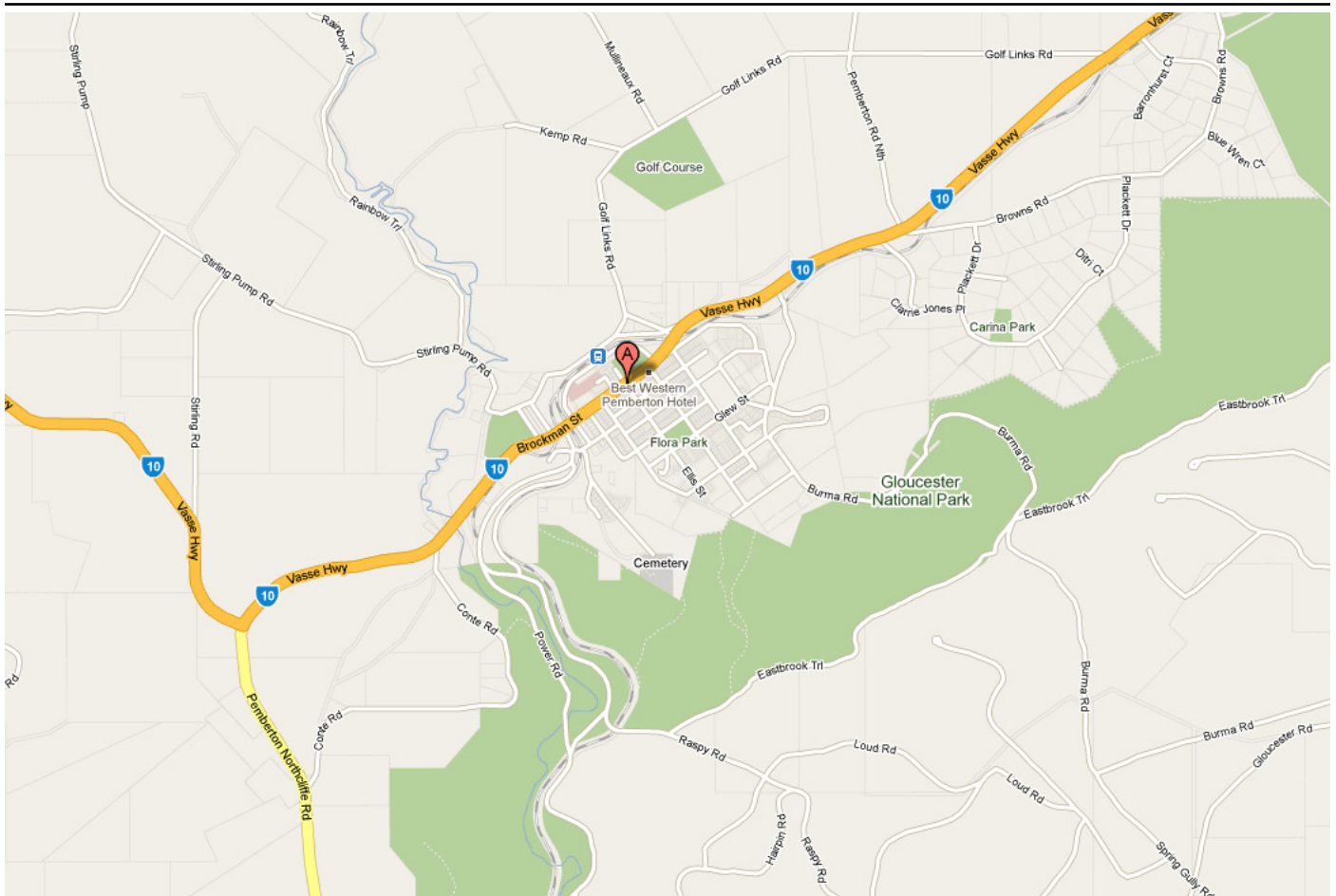
Turn Right out of Clover Cottage Country Retreat
